Introduction:

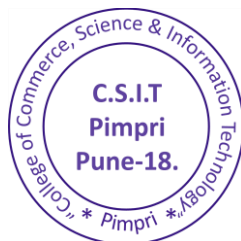

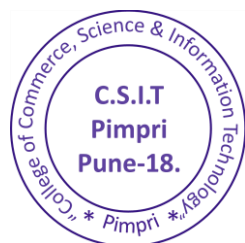
