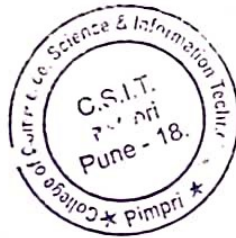

Objectives:

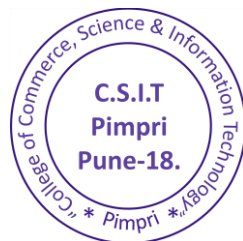
- 1 To promote and celebrate Indian culture, specifically the rich traditions of Dandiya and Garba.

Objectives:

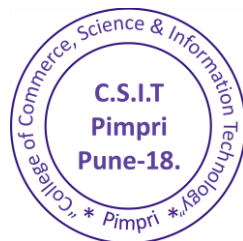
- 1 The event aimed to create an immersive experience that showcased the richness and diversity of Indian culture, particularly the customs associated with Diwali.

The program concluded with vote of thanks giving by Asst. Prof. Monika Jogdand.

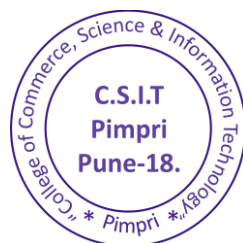

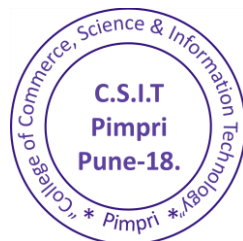

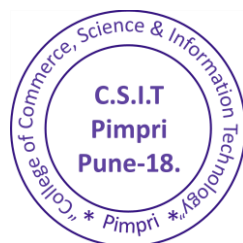
Day 8 –28 February 2024- Meme day/ E-sports
