Detailed Report:

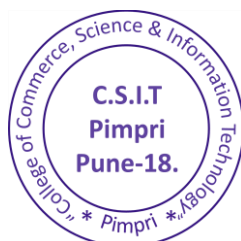

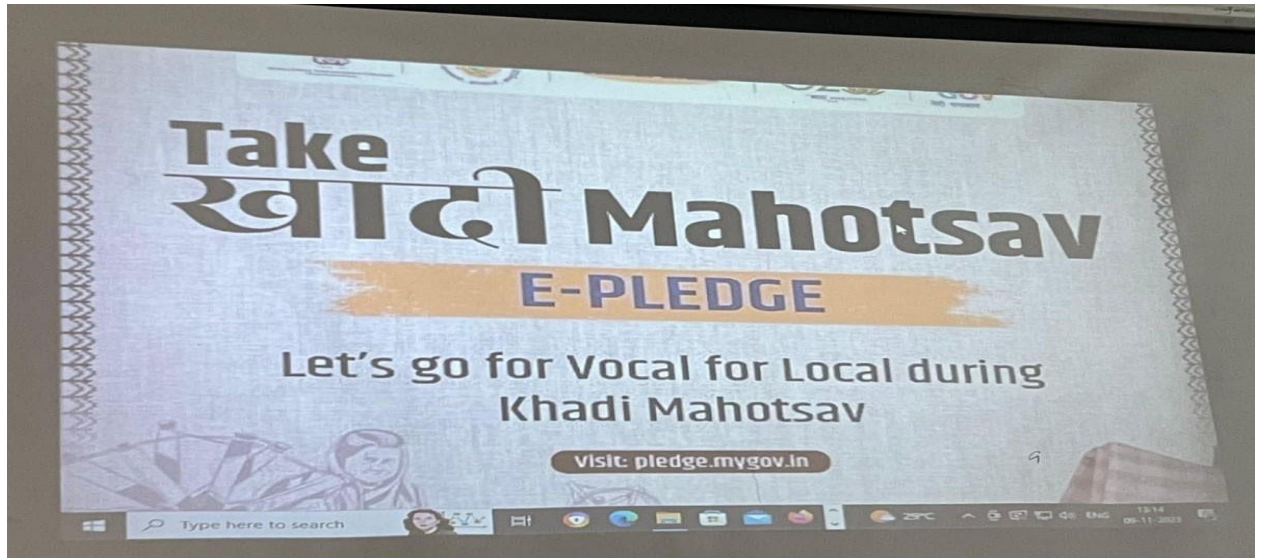
